For the 2023 District Supervisor Election

Androscoggin Valley Soil & Water Conservation District is a legal subdivision of State Government serving Androscoggin and Sagadahoc Counties. It was established to assist local communities with natural resource concerns. The Board of Supervisors directs programs to assist individuals, groups, and municipalities with their conservation needs.

The person elected will serve a three-year term on the Board of Supervisors for Androscoggin Valley Soil & Water Conservation District.

All registered voters within the boundaries of Androscoggin and Sagadahoc Counties are eligible to vote in the election of a District Supervisor for the Androscoggin Valley Soil and Water Conservation District. The candidate receiving a plurality of votes will become the elected Supervisor. In the event of a tie vote, a runoff election will be held.

All ballots must be received by the district office by 3:00PM on November 16th, 2023.
